13. Is the above-named person related in the direct line or in the collateral line (in the second degree) to his/her fiancé/fiancée by legal adoption (Canon 1094)? _____
14. Is there reason to suspect that the above-named person is incapable of contracting marriage because of psychopathology (Canon 1095)? _____
15. Is there any reason to suspect that the above-named person does not know that "marriage is a permanent partnership between a man and a woman, ordered to the procreation of children through some form of sexual cooperation" (Canon 1096)? _____
16. Is there any reason to suspect that the above-named person is in error about the person he/she intends to marry or about a quality of the person, which he/she intends "directly and principally" in marrying him/her (Canon 1097)? _____
17. Is there any reason to suspect that the above-named person is the perpetrator or the victim of deceit perpetrated in order to obtain marriage consent (Canon 1098)? _____
18. Has the above-named person ever expressed error regarding the unity, indissolubility or sacramental dignity of marriage, applied directly to the marriage he/she intends to enter (Canon 1099)? _____
19. Has the above-named person expressed an intention to exclude from his or her marriage marriage itself, an essential element of marriage, or an essential property of marriage (Canon 1101 §2)? _____
20. Has the above-named person expressed a condition concerning the future, to which his/her marriage is to be subjected (Canon 1102 §1)? _____
21. Has the above-named person expressed a condition concerning the past or the present, to which his/her marriage is to be subjected (Canon 1102 §§2, 3)? _____
22. Is the above-named person entering marriage because of force or grave fear imposed from the outside (Canon 1103)? _____
